Director of Emergency Management Update

Access to Kapawe'no First Nation is limited to Residents only.

Security screening is still in effect.

- 1. Security will need to follow the screening tool questionnaire prior to entering.*
- 2. Security will notify the DEM on the following information:*
 - Name*
 - Proof of permanent residency*
 - Reason for returning to the community*
- 3. One family unit visitation protocol*
 - Register at security*
 - Follow Screening Protocols at security.*

Relaunch Stages

Decisions will be applied at both provincial and local levels. An outbreak may result in enhanced health measures being implemented in a local areas.

Enhanced infection prevention and control measures, including physical distancing requirements of at least 2 metres, will remain in place throughout all stages.

Stage 1:

May 14-June 11/20.
Some reopening of businesses and services.

Stage 2:

June 12- current. Further opening of businesses with continued protection in place
